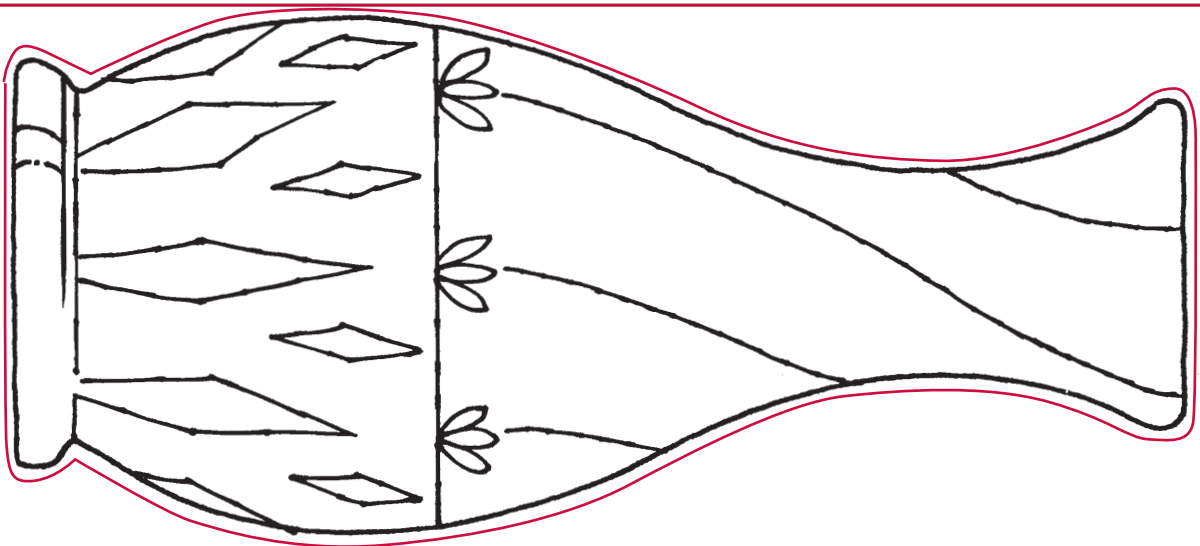
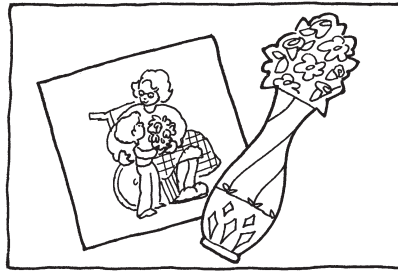




Serve one another in love.

FOR TEACHER

Before class:

- Remove this page from the book.
- Separate the vase from the picture and punch out the vase.
- Remove Figure 7 from the center section of add-on figures.

During class:

- Let your children color the picture to keep and the vase to give away.
- Help each child tape the add-on figure of the flower bouquet to the back of the vase so the flowers show on the front. Tape the bottom of the stems to the X and add another piece of tape to the front where the flowers and vase meet.

Optional:

- You may wish to provide each child with several small dried flowers to tape onto the flowers in the vase. Several dried flowers could also be placed over the flowers in the separate scene. (Add just enough flowers to provide some texture.)
- You may want to add a dot of

perfume to the flowers to give them a nice scent.

Talk about:

- The fact that our actions can show we love Jesus.
- How Paul and Silas helped the Philippian jailer.
- How Jesus' friends can show love for one another.
- How doing something kind, like giving the flowers to someone, shows that we love Jesus.

FOR PARENTS

In class today, the focus of the lesson was that our actions can show we love Jesus. Your child heard about Paul and Silas helping the Philippian jailer (Acts 16:25-36).

At home this week, you can help your child discover ways to show Jesus' love by what she does. For example, if you take your child with you to the store, remind her that she shows Jesus' love when she waits patiently for others. Review the memory verse together: "Serve one another in love" (Gal. 5:13).
